If students are coming and going within 10 weeks and they have a permanent passport with more than 6 months validity remaining, they do NOT need to apply for a visa. American students will be granted a 90 day visa-exempt entry at the airport upon arrival in Taiwan.

If students will be staying in Taiwan more than 90 days, they need to apply for a Taiwanese visa. Students may use their Admission Letter to apply for their Taiwanese visa.
